

Iowa AHA Registration Form For The 2011 Regional Youth Team Tournament “Recognized”

Youth will be allowed to compete in more than one Recognized team again. Please send in a form for each horse and the classes you will show in most often at the IOWA shows and the REGION XI Championship show since these are the ONLY shows that will be counted for this division.

The Regional Team tournament program offers kids in each AHA region the chance to compete in shows, while developing a feeling of camaraderie and sportsmanship. Team points are accumulated throughout the year by team members in either the AHA Recognized or Non-AHA Recognized Divisions. Year end awards are presented to the highest scoring team in each region by AHA. Region XI generously supplies awards to all six teams in both divisions.

The placings will be selected on the basis of points accumulated in shows attended by the team in that tournament year. The highest scoring *four shows* will be totaled and used to determine the winner.
