You may include original artwork, drawings, photography, poetry, etc. to enhance the presentation. (50%)

Essays will be critiqued on the following:

- Grammar & Mechanics (25%)
- Creativity (25%)
- Essay Content (50%)

Essays will be critiqued by a university professor and the scholarship committee. The scholarship committee will make the final selection after thorough reviewing all applications and the critiqued essays. The award is \$750 for 1st place.

ALL CRITERIA must be fulfilled in order to be considered for the scholarship/award. If no application meets the criteria, no scholarship will be awarded.
