All classes are open to all breeds and all ages, unless noted in the class description. Riders may cross enter all classes.

SHOW TERMINOLOGY

Classic Type classes Horses will be presented and judged as Arabians or Half-Arabians.

Saddle Type classes Horses will be presented and judged as gaited breeds such as

Saddlebreds, Tennessee Walkers, or Morgans.

Stock Type classes Horses will be presented and judged as stock breeds such as Paints or

Quarter Horses.

Colorbreed classes Open to horses of color such as Palominos, Buckskins, and Pintos.

Non-Colorbreed classes Open to horses not eligible for the Colorbreed classes.

Mounted Native Costume Open to Arabians and Half-Arabians. Perform at walk, canter, and hand

gallop. Native Costume attire is required.

Pleasure classes Horses will show at walk, jog/trot, and lope/canter. Hand gallop may be

called in Hunter Pleasure classes.

Versatility class Horses will perform under saddle as walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope in

each direction. Following the performance portion, horses will untack and

show at halter.

Liberty Horses will perform at liberty to music without a halter for 2 minutes.

Following the 2 minute time period, the music will stop and the handlers will have an additional 2 minutes to catch the horse. Failure to do so results in disqualification. Horses are expected to perform at all gaits and

use the full arena.

Novice Class Horse/Rider (listed in class description) has not won more than 3 classes

in that discipline.

Junior Horse Horses that are age 5 or under.

Switch-A-Ride Pairs Perf. Horses will perform side by side at the walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope in

both directions of the ring. On the reverse, riders will switch horses.

Leadline Walk-Trot Equitation This class is placed based on the rider's equitation. Each exhibitor will

show at the walk and trot while on a lead.
